DORMITION FAST

Thursday, August 1, is the beginning of the two week Fast before the celebration of the Feast of the Dormition of the Mother of God on August 15.

The Church proclaims a Fast rom Augut1-14. It is a fast that prepares us to celebrate the Feast of Mary's Falling Asleep in the Lord, her Resurrection and Ascension into heaven by calling to mind our own death and the need for repentance and communion with our heavenly Father.

Let us follow the words and wisdom of St. Herman of Alaska: "From this day forth. from this minute, from this hour, let us love God above all else". If we hold this thought during the Fast and the rest of our lives, we will be sue to grow in faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and n the Holy Orthodox Church.
